- Lower implementation costs and higher ROI.


How does it work?

DocUp makes it possible to import CFE from K2B's Electronic Invoicing Module or from another e-invoicing services provider, as well as other non-electronic documents loaded manually.

Based on the document loaded, **DocUp** automatically triggers the corresponding approval flow, including, for example, forwarding an invoice to a particular user according to the provider, and identifying invoices pending approval, rejecting invoices as applicable or due to expiration.

DocUp enables you to manage and allow diverse information-related viewing permissions by enabling each user different activities depending on their roles within the organization.

Allows the possibility to quickly search, follow-up and learn about the status of any document or tax receipt. It also enables access to viewing documents on digital format and state approval or disapproval and integrate it in K2B, with the document accounted for in the Accounts Payable module.
